Continuing Education

Also know as the "Update Clinic"

If you have not attended a clinic since "2015" you will lose your certifications next June if you do not attend a clinic this year. CO is excluded. That means that you need to have a 'Last Clinic Season' of 2016, 2017, or 2018 (this season). If your last season is 2016 you need a clinic this year to stay current.

Important rule changes for season 17-18

All non-scored events will now be required to use CERTIFIED start and finish referee's, just like scored events. Be sure that you have your people trained up by getting them to a JA/RF clinic this fall. Non-scored races will also need to submit TDTR reports, same as the scored events. All certified officials must update every other year to remain current and will lose certification if update is more than 3 years ago.

printed document with them to give to the clinic instructor. You may not take a clinic without CO this document or a prior CO Clinic

Additional Clinics

Satellite clinic rules are posted on the web site. RMSRO charges \$10/clinic participant and the host club is responsible for all expenses including those of the Instructors.

RMSRO Advancement Procedure

In order to advance in level you are responsible for supplying the RMSRO Board with two completed recommendation forms. We update the database in the spring and again in early winter after the fall clinics have been completed and send lists of upgrades to USSA. RMSRO does not automatically advance anyone.

Activity Record (Work Cards)

If you wish credit and want to advance, we need a record of what races you have worked. To do this you need to send in your Work Card. Download HERE or from RMSRO website and complete it by listing the race days (not race codes) you have worked, along with the details shown. Do NOT submit the USSA record, rather copy the information to your work card.. You will only receive credit for one position per day.
