Clinic check in:

Begins at 8:15 a.m. each morning and classes are from 9:00 am to 5:00 pm for those taking exams. The update and CO clinics will be AM only. Saturday afternoon (Nov 4) we will have some workshops open to everyone

Please bring a current Comp. Guide or ICR (2004) to your clinic, or plan on purchasing an ICR at registration. The cost is \$12.00. While they last.

Friday & Saturday Nights Nov, 3 & 4

Coaches Clinic A combined CO & RF clinic. If you are on snow during the day you can sign up for this clinic. Starting time is 6:00pm

Saturday, November 4

Competition Official (CO) AM only. (This is a prerequisite for all other clinics). If you are current as a CR, RA, RF, CR, CC, TC, DM, or TD you are not required to participate in a CO Clinic.) **If you are new. This is the clinic for you.**

Officials Update (This will cover rule changes and is designed for anyone who needs to update their officials status). AM only

Workshops: PM. (open to all). This clinic will include Timing Problems, Computer & Timing Interface.

Chief of Race. (CR) all day. Covers race organization and protocol

Data Management (DM) all day. Covers computer use and data transfer between computers.

Sunday, Nov. 5 (must have CO clinic 1st)

Referee (RF) Also for JA. Covers the basic rules of ski racing

Race Administration (RA) Cover the duties of the Secretary and reporting requirements

Basic Timing & Calculation (TC1) (bring a calculator) Covers the rules pertaining to timing

Advanced Timing & Calculation (TC3) (bring a calculator) Must have a TC1 certification.

USSA TD Update (TD) Open to level 3 Officials

RMSRO Change in Advancement Procedure

Starting in the spring of "06" (last spring) we met to advance all members that had fulfilled the requirements for advancement, i.e.: worked the correct number of days and had 2 recommendations turned in. We did this so the RMSRO records would be the same as those at USSA. All of the advancements were sent to USSA in early June. For those of you who sent in your activity cards after the end of May, we will update the data base and award any advancements next spring.

Activity Record (Work Cards)

If you wish credit and want to advance, we need a record of what races you have worked. The easiest way to do this is to send in your work card (every year). If you don't have one, please send a list of what race days you worked, the name of the race, number of days, and your position. USSA keeps track of days worked on USSA Scored events only. Check it out @ USSA.ORG

USSA Background Screening

USSA is requiring background screening before any Coach or Official will be issued a license. You must go to www.ussa.org, Membership Tools, Background Screening Info, to complete the process. This is a requirement from the liability insurance company. Officials must be current members, not "pending". This eliminates the on-site membership for these positions. If you have sent in your money and not received a license it is because you have not completed the process. Please do so. The screening process takes a minimum of 10 business days.
