Update Requirement

USSA Alpine Officials who are certified as a Jury Adviser, Referee or Technical Delegate are required to attend an update/clinic at least every two years to maintain certification. Our current roster lists the last year that we have a record of a clinic/update. Members who took a clinic last fall are listed as "08". If you did not attend a clinic last fall you need to attend one this fall to remain current.

Friday & Saturday Nights Oct. 31 & Nov.1

Coaches ONLY Clinic: Starting at 6:00 pm

CO/RF combined clinic, if you are on snow during the day you can attend this clinic.

Saturday, November 1

Competition Official (CO) AM only.

If you are new, this is the clinic for you.

This is a prerequisite for all other clinics.

Officials Update AM only Certified Officials Only

This will cover rule changes and is designed for anyone who needs to update their official's status.

Workshops: PM. (Open to all).

This clinic will include Timing Problems, Computer & Timing Interface.

Chief of Race (CR) All Day—prerequisite -CO clinic

Covers race organization and protocol

Data Management (DM) All Day-prerequisite-CO clinic

Covers computer use & data transfer between computers. You should have a laptop and usb drive. A basic understanding of computer use is required including ability to install software, transfer files and file management. **You must have access to your C:/ drive and permission to install software.**

Sunday, Nov. 2 _All Day – CO is a prerequisite for all clinics

Referee (RF)or (JA) Jury Advisor.

Covers the basic rules of ski racing. Required for Start and Finish Referees

Race Administration (RA)

Covers the duties of the Secretary and reporting requirements

Basic Timing & Calculation (TC1) (calculator required) Covers the rules pertaining to timing.

Chief of Course.

A new clinic that will cover Chief of Course requirements. Must be a CR or RF-1 and have proven skiing ability. Clinic numbers will be limited.

Saturday, November 8

USSA TD Update (TD) Open to all Level 3 Officials

All USSA TD's must attend a clinic every 2 years.

All level 3 officials and any club/area hosting USSA or FIS events are encouraged to attend. This clinic covers the update requirement for RF/JA. This will be an all day clinic

RMSRO Advancement Procedure

In the spring (May) we meet to advance all members that had fulfilled the requirements for advancement, i.e.: turned in work cards that showed they have worked the correct number of days and also had 2 recommendations turned in. We did this so the RMSRO records would be the same as those at USSA. All of the advancements are sent to USSA in early June. For those of you who sent in your activity cards after the end of May, we will update the data base and award any advancement in the early winter after the clinics and send the information to USSA.

Activity Record (Work Cards)

If you wish credit and want to advance, we need a record of what races you have worked. To do this you need to send in your work card (every year). If you don't have one, please send a list of what race days you worked, the name of the race, number of days, and your position. USSA keeps track of days worked on USSA Scored events and some non-scored events. You can print it out at USSA.ORG
