Important Notice

The USSA rule is: (page 64 acr)
USSA Alpine Officials who are certified as TD, RF, JA, CR, CC, TC & RA are required to attend an update/clinic at least every two years to maintain certification.

- If an official has missed an update for 3 or more years, he/she may be reinstated to the previous level by passing the appropriate examination.

This rule has been in place for a number of years and the RMSRO Board felt the need to comply. At our November Board meeting the following motion was passed:

To remove certification of officials who have missed an update by 3 or more years, effective 06-30-11, CO certification excluded.

In June all officials that have not attended a clinic since 2008 will have their certifications removed.

Satellite Clinics:

Satellite clinic rules are posted on the web site. RMSRO needs a minimum of 2 weeks to find teachers and post the clinic on the web. The cost is \$10 each and the host club is responsible for all expenses including Instructors.

RMSRO Advancement Procedure

In order to advance in level you are responsible for supplying the RMSRO Board with two completed Recommendation forms. In the spring (May) the Board meets to advance all members who have fulfilled the requirements for advancement, i.e.: turned in work cards indicating the correct number of days worked and have two recommendations. RMSRO recommended advancements are sent to USSA in early June. For those who sent your activity cards after the end of May. We update the data base and award any advancement in the early winter after the fall clinics have been completed and send a second list of upgrades to USSA. RMSRO does not automatically advance anyone. You need to turn in your history and supply us with 2 recommendations

Activity Record (Work Cards)

If you wish credit and want to advance, we need a record of what races you have worked. To do this you need to send in your work card. If you don't have one, please send a list of what race days you worked, the name of the race, number of days, and your position. A facsimile of the RMSRO work card can be downloaded from the RMSRO web site, and filled out with your information. USSA keeps track of days worked on USSA scored events for some positions, but please do NOT submit the USSA record, rather copy the information to your work card. If you miss one or more years, you can still send in your work history for credit. You may not, however, submit work history for a year or years prior to a year for which you have already submitted your work history.
