<u>Additional Clinics</u>

Satellite clinic rules are posted on the web site. RMSRO needs a minimum of 2 weeks to find teachers and post the clinic on the web. RMSRO charges \$10/clinic participant and the host club is responsible for all expenses including those of the Instructors.

RMSRO Advancement Procedure

In order to advance in level you are responsible for supplying the RMSRO Board with two completed recommendation forms. We update the database in the spring and again in early winter after the fall clinics have been completed and send lists of upgrades to USSA. RMSRO does not automatically advance anyone.

Activity Record (Work Cards)

If you wish credit and want to advance, we need a record of what races you have worked. To do this you need to send in your Work Card. Download HERE or from RMSRO website and complete it by listing the race days (not race codes) you have worked, the name of the race, number of days, and your position. USSA keeps track of events worked, but please do NOT submit the USSA record, rather copy the information to your work card. If you miss one or more years, you can still send in your work history for credit. You may not, however, submit work history for a year or years prior to a year for which you have already submitted your work history. You will only receive credit for one position per day.
