THIRD YEAR OF SEPARATE USSA RULES

The USSA Alpine Competition Regulations are provided in an updated format in the USA 2002 Competition Guide. Section 7 beginning on page 116 contains these rules and is all inclusive. Limited changes have been made since last year. These changes will be covered at our annual clinics. We will continue to have numerous distinctions between FIS and USSA event rules as specified by the ICR and Competition Guide respectively. If you have already registered and paid your annual USSA dues you should have already received the 2002 Competition Guide Alpine.

ALPINE OFFICIALS CERTIFICATION

New Alpine Official Officials Guidelines were approved at the annual USSA Meeting held in Park City, Utah in May 2001. These new Guidelines will be in effect for this 2001 – 2002 season. It is now required that all new officials complete the Competition Official (CO) Course, as a prerequisite to pursuing any other officials certifications. Limited additional information is included in the 2002 Competition Guide on page 118 and complete information will be available at the RMSRO clinics to be held in Frisco in November 2001.
