SafeSport Training

All Coaches, Officials and Club Volunteer members are required to complete SafeSport training in order to have an active membership. The initial training is required every two years with a refresher course in between. The SafeSport system is available to all U.S. Ski & Snowboard members at safesport.org. Account can be setup by using your 7-digit member number.

Continuing Education (Update Clinic)

If you have not attended a clinic since 2016 you will lose your certifications next June if you do not attend a clinic this year. CO is excluded. That means that you need to have a 'Last Clinic Season' of 2017, 2018, or 2019 (this season). If your last season is 2017 you need a clinic this year to stay current.

CO - Competition Official - Prerequisite for all other clinics. CO is now available [ONLINE](#)

All persons who wish to take a skill position clinic (RF, RA, CC, CR, TC) MUST complete the ONLINE CO Quiz and bring their printed document with them to give to the clinic instructor before being allowed into another clinic.

RF - Only Coaches may attend

- Nov 2 & 3 (2 evenings required) starting at 6 pm

CR -Chief of Race

- Nov 3 (Full Day) starting at 9 am

CC -Chief of Course

- Nov 3 (Full Day) starting at 9 am

RA - Race Administration – Race Result Software is now part of the RA clinic

There are 2 separate RRS clinics. Computer required (with software installed)

- Nov 3 RRS: Vola 2 pm
- Nov 3 RRS: Split Second 6 pm
- Nov 4 RA (Full Day) starting at 9am
(Must attend an afternoon/evening RRS clinic first)

Additional Clinics

Satellite clinic rules are posted on the web site. RMSRO charges \$10/clinic participant and the host club is responsible for all expenses including those of the Instructors.

RMSRO Advancement Procedure

In order to advance in level you are responsible for supplying the RMSRO Board with two completed recommendation forms. We update the database in the spring and again in early winter after the fall clinics have been completed and send lists of upgrades to USSA. RMSRO does not automatically advance anyone.

Activity Record (Work Cards)

If you wish credit and want to advance, we need a record of what races you have worked. To do this you need to send in your Work Card. Download [HERE](#) or from RMSRO website and complete it by listing the race days (not race codes) you have worked, along with the details shown. Do NOT submit the USSA record, rather copy the information to your work card. You will only receive credit for one position per day.
