The RMSRO annual meeting will be in person at the CMC Campus on Nov 1st followed by the TD Workshop. RA Workshop

This is the second year the RA workshop is required for all RA's to attend on an annual basis. This workshop will be offered via a zoom presentation.

This is now an annual requirement for all certifications (update for RF, CC, CR, JA, RA, TC). All CE Clinics will be virtual presentation via Zoom. Additional clinics will be added as needed.

RMSRO Advancement Procedure

To advance in level, you will need two favorable letters of recommendation. Database updates are completed in the spring and again in early winter after the fall clinics have been completed. RMSRO does not automatically advance anyone.

Activity Record (Work Cards)

Activity work cards need to be submitted at the end of each season to obtain credit needed for advancement. Download from the RMSRO website and complete it by listing the race days (not race codes) you have worked.
